# 2015 FRC Sweetheart Competition Rules & Guidelines

### AGE REQUIREMENTS

- Sweetheart-female contestants must not be less than 10 years of age and no more than 18 years of age as of January 1st before the competition.
- Jr Sweetheart-female contestants must be 9 years of age or less as of January 1st before the competition.

### **ELIGABILITY**

- Contestants must be a member in good standings at Farmersville Riding Club.
- If you are under 18 years of age as of January 1st you must at ALL times be with your legal guardian, and you must also have written consent before you enter this competition.
- All contestants shall agree in writing to observe and comply with all of these rules and regulations.
- Sweethearts <u>MUST</u> be able to carry a flag on their horse.
- Jr Sweethearts depends on the child.
- ALL contestants 21 & under should not become married and/or pregnant during or before the competition. If this were to occur, all prizes/moneys and special awards and ALL items given by FRC are to be returned FRC Board of Directors.
- In the event the FRC sweetheart is unable or does not fulfill his/her duties, it must be brought to the
  attention of the FRC Board of Directors. They will make a determination as to whether the RunnerUp will take over in the reining position.
- Contestants must conduct themselves in a sportsmanship like manner at all times. Good manners, no cursing, no smoking and or drinking of alcoholic beverages. This also includes your TWITTER.

### JUDGING

- Sweethearts will be judged and regulated on a point system in the following categories and point totals:
- Up to 50 pts to be awarded during reining pattern -see attached pattern in packet
- Up to 25pts to be awarded for contestants that sell \$150 dollars of advertisement if not all \$150 is sold partial points will be given in the amount of 10pts
- Up to 25pts to be awarded to the contestant in the interview process at the judge's discretion
- Judging panel will consist of 3 judges that do not know the contestants.

### **EVENTS**

- At any events requiring the contestants to be mounted, each contestant shall provide the horse to be used by her, together with all necessary saddles, bridles, and other equipment, and at her sole cost and expense transport the horse to and from the site of the function.
- Each contestant shall provide her own transportation to each such function, performance, and/or event.
- Once awarded the new Sweethearts will be required to attend at least three (3) events to represent the Farmersville Riding Club.
- Any contestant and/or parent of a contestant wishing to contest any of the rules or results of the
  competition must file a written dispute with the Board of Directors of FRC within 24 hours of the
  announcement of the winners. Upon receipt of this written dispute the Board of Directors at their
  Discretion will review it and hold any necessary meetings, as they deem appropriate.


Horsemanship Pattern #2 - 25 points

This category will be judged by the selected panel of judges.

b. This pattern is designed for the area, Sweetheart, and Prince, (depending on age of Prince - if 8 & under, Prince will follow the Princess pattern).

c. Walk to position A. Begin a figure 8, work to the right at a fast lope and make the larger figure 8. Reduce speed to go into smaller figure 8. Stop at position B. Trot to position C. Begin fast pace at position C, coming to a stop at position D. Turn away from the fence at position D and proceed to the exit gate at a fast pace, doing a presentation ride saluting the crowd. Stop at the gate and exit the arena.



#### Section 9

Horsemanship Pattern #1 (Princess) - 25 Points

- a. This category will be judged by the selected panel of judges.
- b. This pattern is designed for the Princess and depending on age of Prince if 8 & under, Prince will follow this pattern):
- c. Enter the arena and circle the arena at a slow lope. Make a second circle around the arena as a presentation ride, saluting the crowd. Half way around the third lap, go to the middle of the arena, stop your horse and position yourself in the center of the arena. You must be able to control your horse in the same position for several minutes during the announcement of the other contestants.

### Section 10

Personality - 25 points

- a. This category will be judged by the panel of judges.
- b. The judges will form their opinions during the course of the competition and personal interview.

### Section 11

Appearance - 25 points

- During the horsemanship competition, the contestants will be required to wear black or dark denim jeans, cowboy boots, cowboy hat, long sleeve western button front shirt and belt.
- b. Your outfit needs to be neat and clean.
- c. Your horse should be well groomed as your horse's appearance is also judged.
- d. This category will be judged by the panel of judges.

## Section 12

## Personal Interview - 50 points

- a. This category will be judged by the panel of judges.
  b. The interview will be from 5-15 minutes in length. The panel will ask questions about the contestant's history with riding, their horse, school activities, etc.
  c. There will be no standard questions asked and contestants may be asked different questions.
